

## AST repair bladders inflate, keep roof afloat

**Pontoon liners (repair bladders)** like this are for aboveground storage pontoon floating roof tanks.

They install inside the pontoon, are inflated to displace



product, then keep a roof afloat, declares the maker.

Most commonly these liners are used in a pontoon that has begun to leak — and can fill with tank product to cause a floating roof to sink with subsequent damage.
